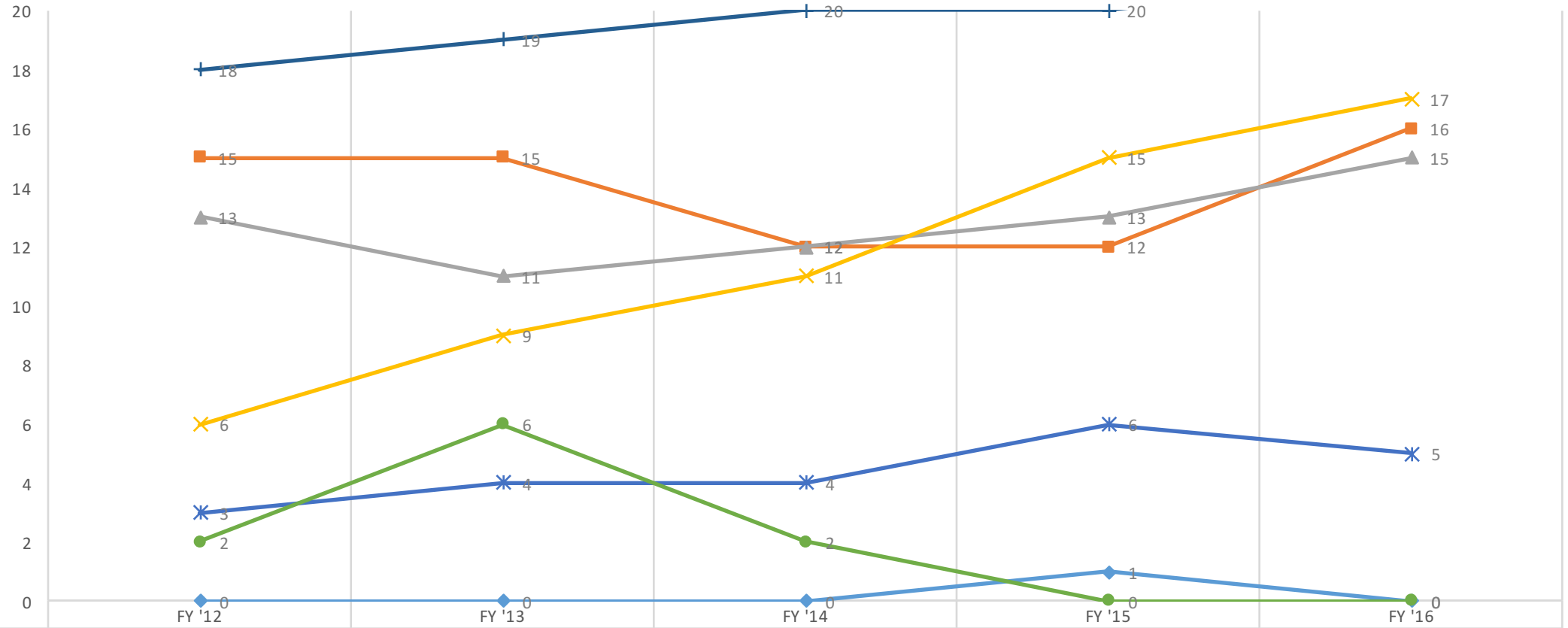


Wesleyan University Staff & Faculty Demographics FY '12-FY '17

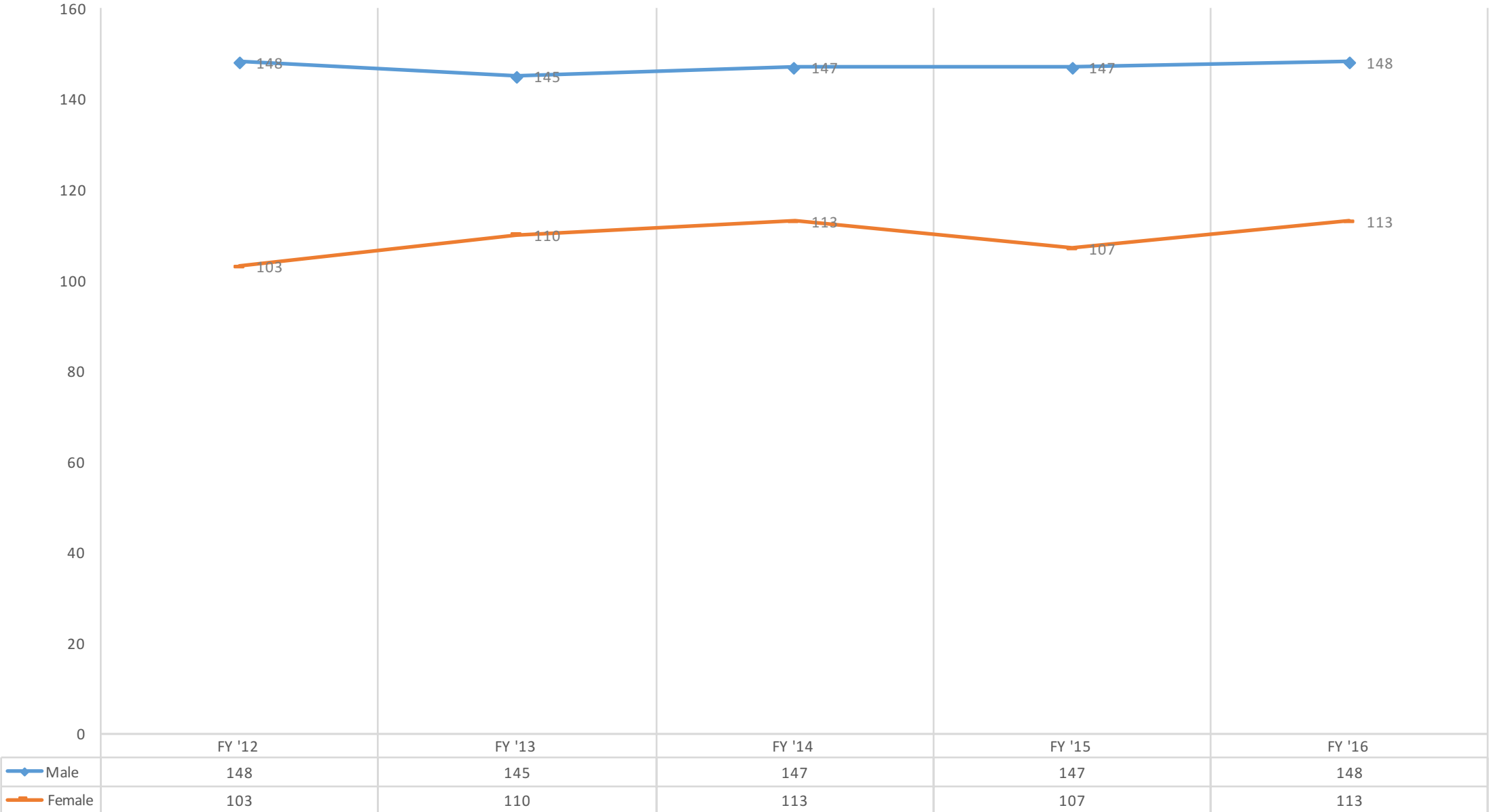

WESLEYAN TENURE TRACK FACULTY BY RACE FY '12 - FY '16

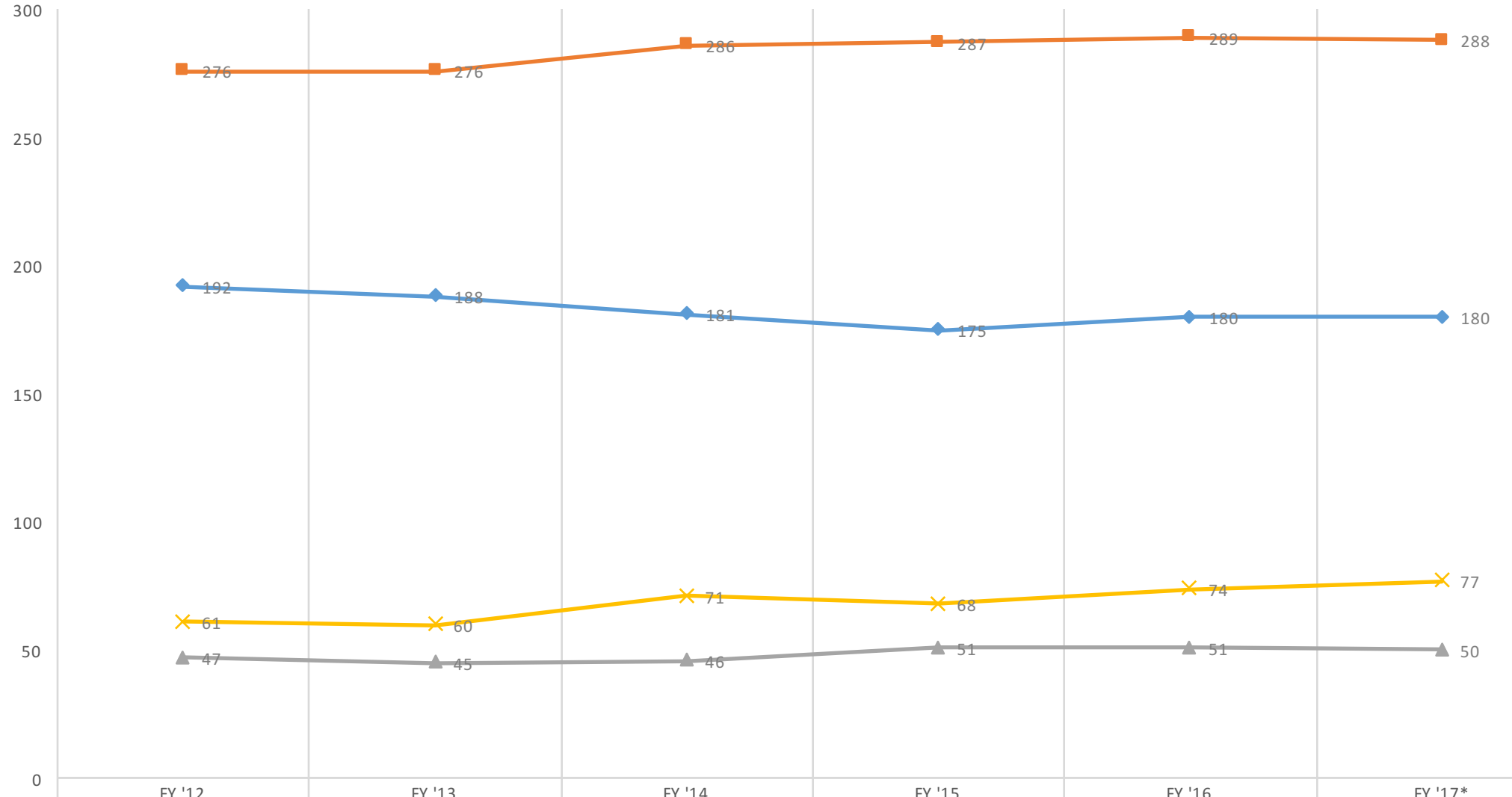

WESLEYAN TENURE TRACK FACULTY BY GENDER FY '12 - FY '16

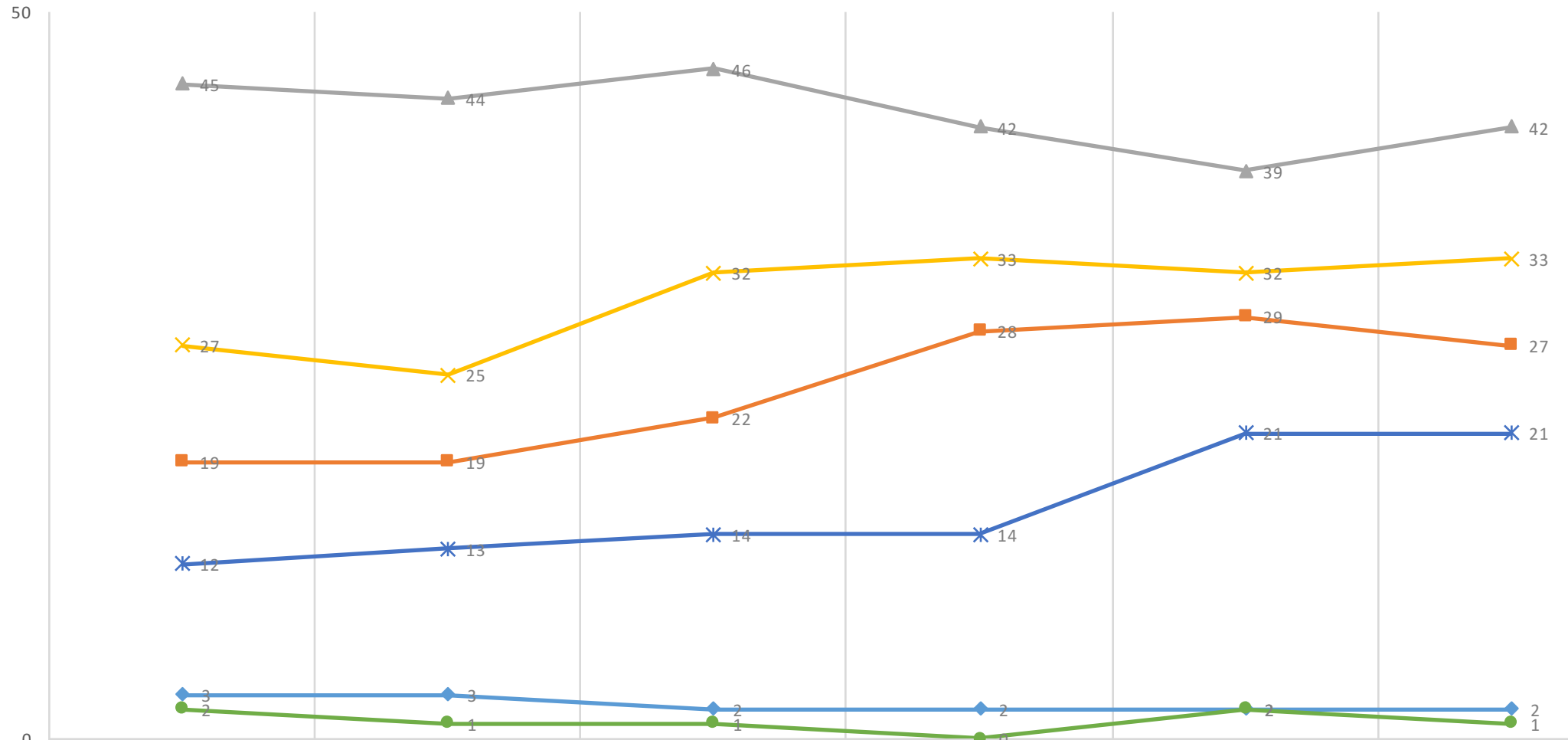
